We will also recount changes that have occurred in our own lives and develop an understanding of concepts such as civilisation, monarchy, parliament, democracy, and war and peace.</p> <p>As geographers, we will learn about a significant local place (Bath) and ask questions such as: <i>What is this place like? What or who will I see in this place? What do people do in this place?</i> We will also be identifying the key features of a location in order to say whether it is a city, town, village, coastal or rural area.</p> <p>As scientists, we will be exploring different materials, distinguishing between objects and the materials from which they are made. We will identify, describe and name the simple physical properties of a variety of everyday materials, including wood, plastic, glass, metal, water, and rock. We will also be observing the changes across the seasons – summer.</p> <p>As designers, we will use materials to practise drilling, screwing, gluing and nailing materials to make and strengthen products.</p>
