Our Curriculum in Term 1



Our enquiry will focus on Geography and Understanding the World where we will be learning about the world around us including the 7 continents.

We will also be learning about animals and where in the world we would find different animals including mammals, reptiles, birds, amphibians and fish.



We will be making observations of the seasons and thinking about the changes that occur as summer moves into autumn. This will link to our learning about Harvest and we will be taking part in the Harvest Service in church.



To develop our creative skills, Year 1 Art lessons will be focused on printing.

Reception pupils will have lots of opportunities to develop their creativity through exploring a range of media as well as role-play and small world play within the continuous provision.

What to bring to school

Every day I need to bring a water bottle, coat and book bag. If I am having a packed lunch, I will need to bring that too.

If I am in Reception, I will need waterproof trousers/puddle suit in school at all times as we like to go outside whatever the weather! Wellies can be left in school on the welly rack outside the classroom.

I must not bring toys, cards or other items from home in to school unless I have been 'Star of the Day' on the previous day, then I can bring in something small to share with the class.

PE Days:

We will do PE on Mondays and Thursdays.



We need to wear our PE kit to school on that day. I should wear a **plain navy** track suit (school hoodie and jogging bottoms), my house colour t-shirt and a pair of trainers. If I do not come into school in appropriate PE kit, a message will be sent home and I will have to change into spare school kit.

School Lunches:

Please make sure school lunches are booked before coming into school (even if I am having packed lunch). Lunches can be booked up to 3 weeks in advance.

If I am having a packed lunch, please do not put too much in to it: some children spend the hour eating everything rather than playing.
