Compulsory Weekly Tasks		
Reading Please share a reading experience at least 5 times a week. This can be your child reading to you, you sharing a story, an audio book, instructions for a game etc. Please record <u>any experience</u> in your child's reading diary. These are monitored weekly.	Phonics/Keywords Practice reading sounds and key words. A new set of sounds/words are available each week.	Maths Make comparisons between objects relating to size, length, weight and capacity. <i>*see below for ideas</i>

Measures Ideas	
At the sink or in the bath, play with a selection of different-sized containers. Can you fill and empty the containers? Can you show a container that is full, nearly full, half full, nearly empty and empty? 	Can you order three objects using the language 'heavy', 'heavier' and 'heaviest'? Pick up the objects to feel the weight and compare them. 
Ask your grown-up to give you two mystery bags. One is heavy and one is light. What do you think could be in each bag? Talk about your ideas and draw the object that you think could be in each mystery bag. Are heavy things always big? Are light things always small? 	• Find your favourite toy. • Can you find a toy that is taller? • Can you find a toy that is shorter? • Can you put the toys in order? 
• Can you predict how long the sofa is? • Which is longer: the sofa or the armchair? • Can you place the string in length order, shortest to longest? • Is there another way to measure the length of these objects? 	Collect some different-sized spoons. How many different sizes have you found? How many small spoonfuls does it take to fill a cup? What happens if you use the largest spoon?
