Our Curriculum in Term 2



Our enquiry will continue to focus on Geography and Understanding the World through our next topic: 'All at Sea'. We will be learning about the oceans and how they are important.

We will continue to observe what happens in autumn and how the weather changes throughout this season. As the days get shorter and colder, we will begin to think about how autumn changes into winter.



With Christmas just around the corner, our Religion and Worldviews learning will be focused on Incarnation and we will be thinking about why Christians perform nativity plays at Christmas and why Christmas matters to Christians.

As part of our festive celebrations we will be making lots of Christmas decorations, with Year 1s making decorations using textiles within their DT lessons.

We will be taking part in the Infant Nativity. Reception and Year 1 will be learning two separate songs to perform on stage. A message about costumes will be coming home closer to the time.

What to bring to school

Every day I need to bring a water bottle, coat and book bag. If I am having a packed lunch, I will need to bring that too.

If I am in Reception, I will need waterproof trousers/puddle suit in school at all times as we like to go outside whatever the weather! Wellies can be left in school on the welly rack outside the classroom.

I must not bring toys, cards or other items from home in to school unless I have been 'Star of the Day' on the previous day, then I can bring in something small to share with the class.

PE Days:

We will do PE on Mondays and Thursdays.



We need to wear our PE kit to school on that day. I should wear a **plain navy** track suit (school hoodie and jogging bottoms), my house colour t-shirt and a pair of trainers. If I do not come into school in appropriate PE kit, a message will be sent home and I will have to change into spare school kit.

School Lunches:

Please make sure school lunches are booked before coming into school (even if I am having packed lunch). Lunches can be booked up to 3 weeks in advance.

If I am having a packed lunch, please do not put too much in to it: some children spend the hour eating everything rather than playing.
