Compulsory Weekly Tasks		
Reading Please share a reading experience at least 5 times a week. This can be your child reading to you, you sharing a story, an audio book, instructions for a game etc. Please record <u>any experience</u> in your child's reading diary. These are monitored weekly.	Phonics/Keywords Practice reading sounds and key words. A new set of sounds/words are available each week.	Maths Practise number skills activities <i>*see below for ideas</i>

Number Skills Practise Ideas	
 Ask a grown-up or friend to play a board game with you that includes a dotted dice. Each time the dice is rolled, can you say the number shown without counting the dots? Spread out a selection of mixed-sized building bricks (Lego) on a table or mat. What do you notice about the building bricks? Can you spot any bricks with two studs? Are there any with four? Sort the bricks into sets by subitising the number of studs.  Ask a grown-up to secretly place up to five small items, such as pom-poms, into an empty egg carton so that each item is in its own space. Ask them to quickly show you what's inside before closing the lid. Can you say how many items you saw?  Find ten small objects and two plates. Grab some of the objects and put them on one of the plates. Then, take the rest of the objects and put them on the other plate. Count how many there are on each plate. What number bond did you find? Talk about the number bond. For example, '<i>There are seven on this plate and three on this plate. Seven and three make ten.</i>' Try the game again. What other number bonds can you find? 	<i>*Subitising is when you can look at a group of objects or images, such as dots on a dice, and know how many there are without counting them one by one.</i>
