Enquiry/theme: Science – Everyday Materials <i>To distinguish between an object and the material from which it is made; to identify and name a variety of everyday materials, including wood, plastic, glass, metal, water, and rock; to describe the simple physical properties of a variety of everyday materials.</i> Go on a detective materials hunt around your home! What everyday materials can you find in your home? Can you find things that are made from: Plastic? Glass? Metal? Wood? Fabric? Stone or rock? What are the properties of these materials? Are they hard/soft, strong/delicate, bendy/rigid, bumpy/smooth? Is one material more popular in your house than another? Can you identify any other materials? Due by end of week 8
